Overflowing Power

Ephesians 3:20-21

As a boy growing up in Baltimore, our neighborhood swimming pool appeared on any hot Saturday night when the fire marshal would come and open the hydrant. All the kids would run outside and have fun playing in the water gushing from the hydrant. But one thing always confused me about this mysterious red hydrant, so I asked my dad. "How can this one three-foot pipe contain so much water?"

My dad quickly explained, "Son, that pipe has no water in it at all. The water is in the reservoir and the fire hydrant delivers the water here from there." That small hydrant was able to provide a powerful delivery because it was ultimately connected to a huge source.

If there is no abiding connection with God through prayer, there is no access to the vast resources of God's kingdom authority and power. God is the reservoir and He is able to supply all that you need, but there has to be a connection beneath the surface, in your soul and spirit.

The apostle Paul describes that abundant power as he says in Ephesians 3:20-21, "Now to Him who is able to do far more abundantly beyond all we can ask or think, according to the power that works in us, to Him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, for ever and ever! Amen."

That's the best news we can receive; God is able. Jesus is able to do far and beyond what you can ask or even think of. He comes through in ways you never expected. Abiding prayer grants you access to more of God's power, forever and ever!
