Disaster to Determination

When Reserve, Louisiana took a direct hit from Hurricane Ida, most of the community was without power for weeks, but that didn't stop the First Baptist Church. Home Bible studies began throughout the town, and when power was restored, the church delivered food and supplies, becoming a hub of compassionate care. "I didn't know Louisiana Disaster Relief was funded through the Georgia Barnette Offering until we needed help after Hurricane Ida," Pastor Robert Roussel noted. 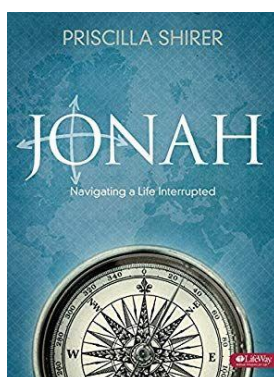
