WHERE Will You Live Again?

During weekly staff meetings, we continue to examine the life woes of Job. In chapter 14, we see where this poor man is in the throes of despair. Job even questions eternal life when he laments in asking: "If a man dies, will he live again? All the days of my struggle I will wait until my change comes."

Charles Swindoll asks us to meditate on this question: When you die, **where** will you live again? The choices are heaven or hell. Will you enjoy eternal bliss, joy and reward? Or eternal judgment, away from God and all that you hold dear? Only you can determine which.

C.S. Lewis wrote this: "There's no doctrine which I would more willingly remove from Christianity than the doctrine of hell, if it lay in my power. But it has the full support of scripture and especially of our Lord's own words. It has always been held by Christendom and it has the support of reason."

C.S. Lewis was no intellectual pushover. His words deserve serious consideration. Swindoll tells us the good news is that trials and tribulations are only in this life. But once we're in our Lord's presence, all that changes.

I love the wonderful promise of scripture that is found in the New Testament, 1 Corinthians 2:9, "Eye hath not seen, nor ear heard, neither have entered into the heart of man, the things which God hath prepared for them that love Him."

Let's continue to find hope, promise and strength in knowing Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior, through the power of the Holy Spirit.

Praise the name of Jesus forevermore, that we have that blessed assurance of eternal life! *Evo. Harold*
