minutes, black smoke and the smell of burnt rubber filled the air as loud pops and snaps were heard through the flames. With her precious toddler clinging to her, Bridget explained she was driving down Buncombe

Road and her car began to lose power. Even though no warning lights appeared on the dash, she knew she should get off the road and get her

baby out of the car. Sometimes, calamity falls upon us without any warning lights. We're going along and then suddenly, our situation is on fire. Panic wells up and the enemy convinces us there is no way out; we will be overcome.
