In Deuteronomy 6:5, God instructed Moses to tell the nation of Israel: "Love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength." In the New Testament, when Jesus was asked about the greatest commandment, He quoted this verse. (Matthew 22:37 and Mark 12:30)


