
# You'll Avoid Tunnel Vision

In reading only certain parts of the Bible, we limit our view of the big story God has written. Many feel more comfortable staying within the New Testament because it seems easier to understand. But the reality is that we cannot fully grasp the Gospel-wonder of the New Testament apart from reading the Old Testament first. If we read only certain books, we limit our spiritual perspective and develop tunnel vision. This is why it is vital to read the entirety of Scripture, even the books difficult to grasp. You will be surprised by what God allows you to see by His grace as you read outside your comfort zone and trust Him for the outcome.
