Kristen Wetherell's *Seventeen Benefits to Reading the Entire Bible* presents Reason #1:

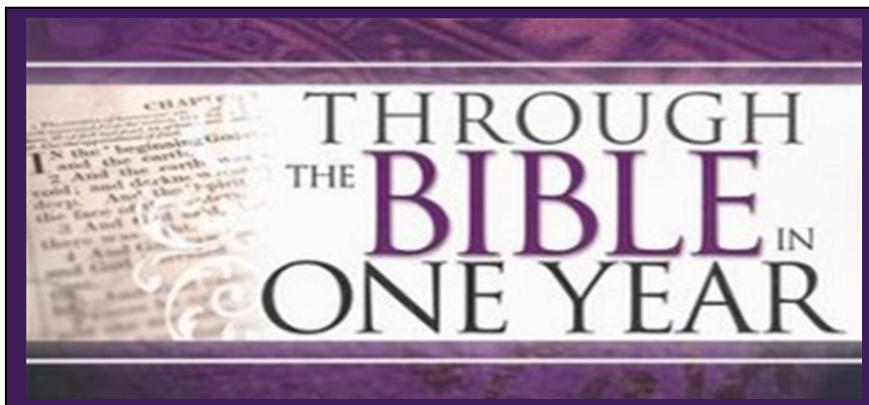
You'll Know God Better
