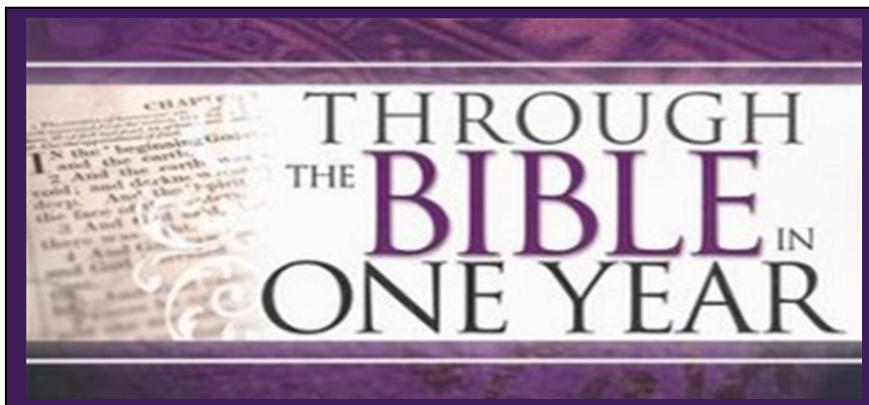
You'll Know Yourself Better

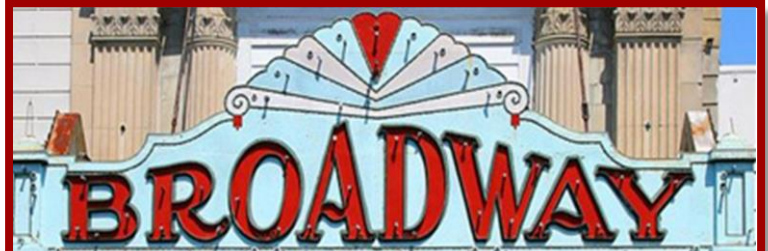
